Wendy Lee talks about The Arts



Building the child's identity as an Artist:

This seminar will explore both the barriers and enablers around building children's identity as artists.

We want children to explore art in a way that will engage them in creative experiences in the world of art. In so doing we will be nurturing the foundation of artistic engagement. We will also look at a range of programme possibilities for developing a strong art based early childhood programme.

Wendy Lee was a Co-director of the National Early Childhood Assessment and Learning Exemplar Project that has developed the Kei Tua o te Pae books. Wendy is also the Director of the Educational Leadership Project (Ltd), a professional development provider for the early childhood sector. Wendy has been involved in the ECE field for 40 years as a teacher, tutor, lecturer, manager, professional development facilitator and researcher. More recently she has lead a research project with Professor Margaret Carr, a TLRI "Learning Wisdom". Wendy has a deep interest in curriculum and leadership issues for ECE.

Wendy has presented at conferences and programmes throughout the world including the UK, Germany, Iceland, Belgium, USA, United Arab Emirates, Norway, Czech Republic, Canada, Australia and Sweden.
