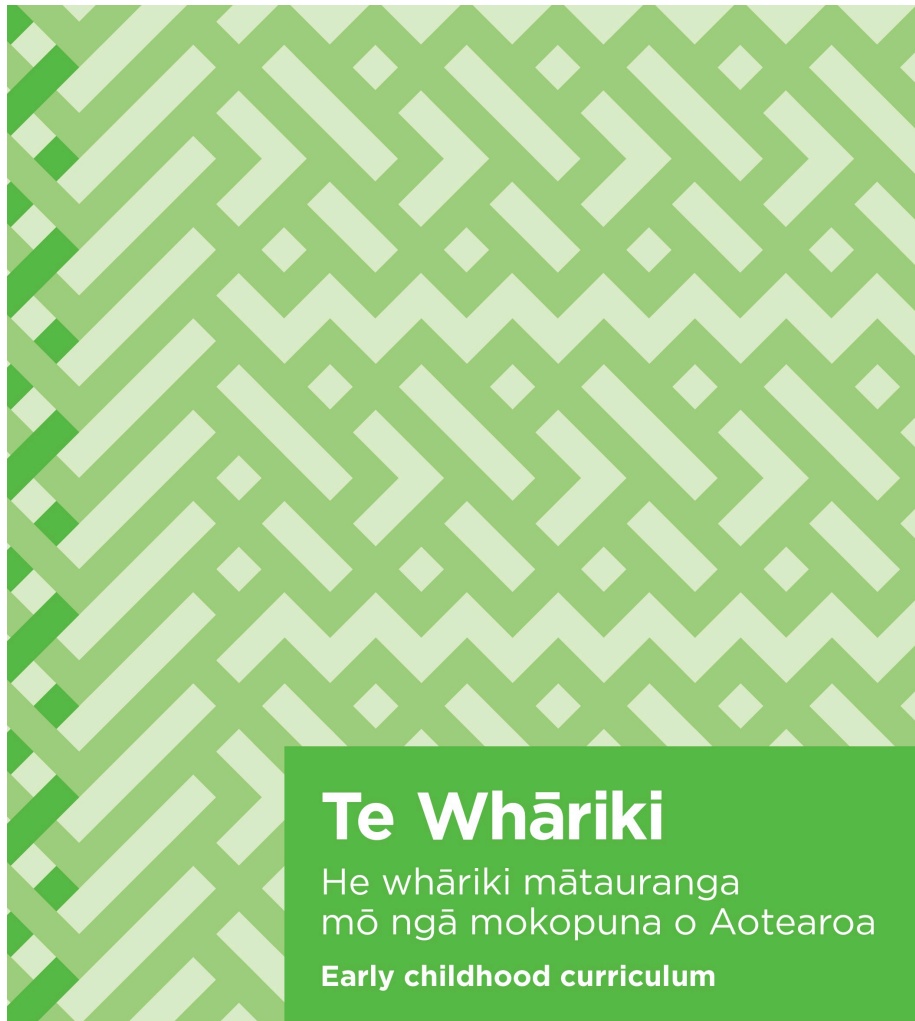

## TE WHĀRIKI (2017) WAIHEKE ISLAND

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**Te Rina Warren** is a Massey University lecturer with particular expertise in indigenous studies and Te Tiriti o Waitangi. Their presentation is about the Treaty in the context of Te Whāriki.

**Mari Ropata-Te Hei** is also a Massey University lecturer. With graphic designer, Te Iwihoko Rangihirawea, Mari developed the updated whāriki graphic and cover. Mari will share the significance of the design.

**Brenda Soutar** is a leader at Mana Tamariki in Palmerston North. She was a member of the writing team for the update of Te Whāriki. Brenda will present a Māori perspective on Te Whāriki as a metaphor for learning within the context of early learning. This includes the significance of harakeke, weaving and whakataukī (proverbs).
