We know a moving child is a learning child and purposeful physical activity is vital for Mary's holistic development. It is great to see Mary so happy in this natural environment and spending time in nature heightens all of our senses, we have about 21 senses! Senses support children to process information when learning, using multiple senses supports cognitive connections and this type of activity is important for Mary's learning. It is great to see Mary engaging in a new climbing task, we look forward to fostering and extending her interest in climbing, whether it be in the park at kindergarten or in the trees at Bush Kindergarten.
