EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

During the professional learning we will be focusing on the outcomes set by Ministry of education:

- Culturally responsive pedagogy
- Building teams
- Growing strong ECE networks
- Principles to practice: Te Whāriki 2017
- Assessment planning and evaluation
- Social and emotional competence



PROGRAMME STRUCTURE:

The professional learning program will start with a leadership day titled ‘*Leading the Te Whāriki Way*’. This will set the scene for the rest of the professional learning, as we focus on ways in which both pedagogical and centre leaders can ensure the positive wellbeing of themselves and teachers. This will also support the growth of a Leadership Network that might be the vehicle for continued support well past this contract.

After we hear back from centres we will tailor a programme in response to the majority of the ideas that you have shared.
